- Completed DS-2029 form** Application
- Minor's Uruguayan Birth Certificate – Original and Two (2) Copies**
- Proof of Parents' U.S. Citizenship - Original and Two (2) Copies**
 - U.S. Birth Certificate; or
 - U.S. Naturalization Certificate; or
 - U.S. Certificate of Citizenship
- Proof of Parents' Identity - Original and One (1) Copy**
 - Previous U.S. Passport; or
 - Other Government ID (Can be U.S. or Foreign Government ID)
- Proof of U.S. Citizen Parent's Physical U.S. Presence**
 - School Transcripts/Records
 - Social Security Benefits Statement or Paycheck Receipts
 - IRS Tax Records
 - Bank Statements, Telephone Statements/Record, or other Utility Bills
 - Photos or other physical evidence of presence in the United States
- Parents' Marriage Certificate (if applicable) Original and Two (2) Copies**
- Parents' Divorce Certificates (if applicable) Original and One (1) Copy**
- Parents' Death Certificate (if applicable) Original and One (1) Copy**
- Fee** – International Credit Card, U.S. Dollars, or Uruguayan Pesos

- Completed DS-11** Application
- 1 - 2"x2" Passport Photo** (5cm x 5cm)
- Fee** – International Credit Card, U.S. Dollars, or Uruguayan Pesos
- Both parents' Government IDs** (For minors under 16 years of age)
- Completed DS-3053 form** (For minors where both parents are not present at the interview)
